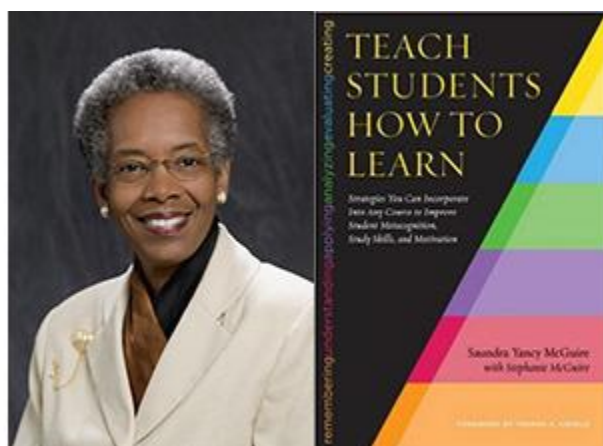


RVGS Guest Speaker Opportunity for Parents

On Sunday, November 18 at 6:30, Dr. Saundra McGuire will present a special lecture for RVGS parents on student study skills and strategies for academic success. Dr. McGuire is an internationally recognized author, lecturer, and retired LSU faculty member. She will provide parents with advice and recommendations for supporting their students based on her book, “Teach Students How to Learn”.
