Our daily schedule is designed to maximize lab opportunities and real-world applications. 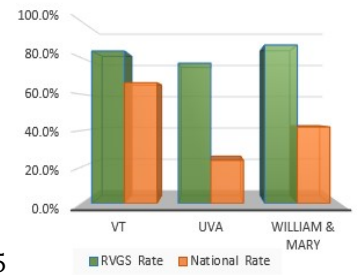
STUDENT RESEARCH
