





Pipettes are in the prep room


Pipette pumps are on the left in LC 3



Transfer pipettes are on the right in UC 1




Micropipetters are in the prep room (see Mr. Smith)

Plastic ones are in the prep room (see Mr. Smith first)




Plastic bottles are in the prep room (see Mr. Smith first)

Glass bottles are on the right in UC 4 (see Mr. Smith first)




Centrifuge tubes (50 mL & 15 mL) are in the prep room (see Mr. Smith)


Plastic storage tubes (see Mr. Smith)



Small glass bottles are in the prep room (see Mr. Smith)




Culture dishes are on the right in UC 3




Scoopulas & spatulas are in the prep room

Volumetric flasks are on the left in UC 8 (you *MUST* see Mr. Smith)




Erlenmeyer flasks are on the left in UC 1 & 2

Smith)






Ring stands & iron rings are on the left in LC 1

Beakers are on the left in UC 3 & 4


Funnels are on the left in UC 7


Filter paper is on the left in UC 9 (see Mr. Smith)
