Virtual Learning Expectations

Students will follow the guidelines and requirements below on any day they attend RVGS lessons virtually. These guidelines serve as an update and supplement to the virtual attendance guidelines provided in August.

Guiding Principle

During virtual learning, students will conduct themselves in the same way they would during in-person attendance. This includes behaviors such as: focus and attention on classwork, on-time attendance, not leaving class early, responsiveness to teacher questions, taking written notes, and study of material after class. *We understand that distance learning can present difficulties, but students are expected to take all steps in their power to rise to the challenge with the RVGS Determined attitude.*

CORE STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Students will take written notes during the class period and submit digital images of all notes and written work:**
 - The submission link is posted on the RVGS website under “Useful Links” and students should bookmark the link on their phone or computer for easy use. A single link is used for all classes.
 - Students will take photos/scan their written notes and any handwritten work promptly at the end of class.
 - Students watching a class recording will submit notes promptly after watching the recording.
 - Submission of these notes is required to verify attendance; failure to submit may result in being marked absent for the day.
- 2. Students will observe appropriate attendance practices**
 - Students are expected to attend class in real-time whenever possible.
 - Students will arrive to their virtual class 5 minutes early to ensure they are fully logged in before instruction begins.
 - Students will not leave the session prior to the end of class without notifying the teacher.
- 3. Students must attentive and engaged throughout the lesson**
 - Students will be prepared to turn on audio and/or video promptly at teacher request.
 - If a student needs to step away briefly (bathroom break, etc.) they will set themselves as “Away” in the Collaborate session.
 - If a student is unresponsive during the lesson, the situation will be referred to the Director.
- 4. Students will maintain a learning environment conducive to learning**
 - Students will keep cell phones off/silenced and put away during class time.
 - Students will work at an appropriate workspace (desk, table, etc.) free of distractions. Efforts will be made to minimize background noise and maintain appropriate background for video.
 - Students will be dressed appropriately to allow video to be used.
